To provide travel for clients that are unable to get to important appointments, attending groups and meetings, or for collections and deliveries of things such as medication.

This is an exciting opportunity for you to enable our clients to obtain all available support that might not otherwise be accessible to them. You will get to work in a 1:1 environment with people and provide support to them on what might be a challenging journey.

What will you be doing?

- Collecting clients from their homes and taking to and returning from appointments at places such as hospitals, rehabs, We Are With You offices
- Delivering prescriptions to or from offices and chemists
- Supporting workers with appropriate journeys as required
- Supporting clients to feel calm and prepared when travelling to and from appointments
- Keeping in contact with staff and clients where appropriate to provide updates and feedback
- Reporting any safeguarding concerns

- Full UK driving licence with Business Insurance cover
- Your own vehicle which is taxed, MOT'd and road worthy
- Work with people in a non-judgmental and solution-focused way
- Able to work independently and as part of a team
- Understand the challenges faced by the people using our services
- To be reliable and punctual when transporting clients
- Ability to manage time effectively
- Basic IT literacy
- Good communication skills
- Ability to respect and maintain confidentiality
