



# Outdoor Winter Rink Volunteer

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## Overview of the Opportunity

We want you to connect with your local rink coordinator and other rink volunteers to work together on creating and maintaining an outdoor rink and a welcoming space for your neighbourhood to utilize and enjoy during winter months!

## Key Responsibilities or Tasks

- Connect with the volunteer rink coordinator to set schedule and ice-making plan
- Assist volunteer rink coordinator in making and maintaining ice by following their direction and guidance
- Regular snow removal and ice maintenance as needed
- Follow all safety and risk management expectations
- Completion of routine rink inspection forms and other forms as required
- Care and minor maintenance of shovels and hose as needed
- Keeping the rink shack clean
- Complete volunteer training (AODA and COVID related training) and complete volunteer registration paperwork
- Responsible for the rink shack key if issued by Volunteer Outdoor Rink Coordinator

## Skills, Experience and/or Requirements

- Live within the neighbourhood that you volunteer for
- Comfortable working independently outdoors in cold temperatures
- Ability to bend, lift
- Ability to volunteer in the early morning or late nights during the winter months as required
- Experience with winter rink creation and maintenance is an asset, not required
- Ability to follow instructions

## Age Criteria

- 18+ (for those under 18, parental/guardian permission is required, for those under 14 –parental/ guardian supervision is required)

## Time Commitment

**Day(s):** Varies and depends on weather. Typically starts in late December and continues until early March, weather permitting.

**Time:** approximately 3 - 6 hours per week; early morning or late night (schedules vary for each rink location and how many volunteers are committed at your rink location)

## Benefits

- Be the star of your neighbourhood by assisting with the operation of a winter rink for ALL to enjoy!
- Hands-on experience for building and maintaining outdoor rink ice surfaces
- Get to know others in your neighbourhood, participate and watch others enjoy the Outdoor Rink

## Additional Thing You Should Know

- This position is physical and requires volunteers to be outdoors typically in the early morning or late night during the winter months
