Overview of the Opportunity

As part of the reopening plans, the role of Golf Greeter has been created to welcome and be the first-point of contact for golfers.

Key Responsibilities or Tasks

- Volunteers must adhere to and comply with all City Of Kitchener's Covid-19 and PPE policy and public health guidelines
- Volunteers must adhere to role specific COVID – 19 procedures (cleaning and sanitation of equipment etc.)
- Welcoming golfers (asking name and tee time) and assisting to provide a great customer experience throughout the day.
- Ask and record COVID-19 screening questions/responses
- Provide details of the day (i.e. washroom location, cart pickup)
- Remind player about facility rules

Skills, Experience and/or Requirements

- Basic reading & writing skills.
- Knowledge of golf is desirable but not necessary
- Ability to provide great customer service (welcoming people, providing information, answering questions etc.)
- Ability to communicate with people in a positive and professional manner
- Ability to adhere to and follow instructions
- Ability to provide clear instructions and/or rules to others
- Ability to follow through on tasks independently once given directions
- Organized and detailed oriented
