

Volunteer Job Description

ROMP In Yard Socializer

Description:

Take dogs out of their kennels for structured enrichment in the play yards.

Volunteer Impact:

Contribute to PRC shelter dogs' emotional, physical and behavioral well being. Contribute to the Every Dog Every Day goal and the freedom to express normal behavior under the Five Freedoms.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Use Play Group Report to select dogs to leash and bring to the play yard.
- Make enrichment notes on report card.
- Return dog to the kennel and check off Every Dog, Every Day Report.
- Take out the next dog on the list and continue process until end of volunteer shift.
- Place used toys and leads in the dirty laundry bin.

Qualifications:

- New Volunteer Orientation.
- Volunteering with Dogs online training.
- ROMP Team online training.
- Shadow with Romp Mentor until training checklist is completed.
- Comfortable with dogs of medium to large size.

Physical Qualifications:

- Work around dogs of varying temperaments.
- Work around loud noises and strong smells.
- Work outside in all weather conditions including heat, rain and cold.
- Able to physically handle dogs of medium to large size who may pull on leash.
- Able to stand and walk for extended period of time.

Time Commitment:

One scheduled shift per week, minimum 3 hours.
