The foster care program plays a crucial role in enabling the HBSPCA to assist a greater number of animals each year. It serves as a vital piece in providing a secure and nurturing environment for animals that require time to heal, develop, and await their forever families for adoption. By providing temporary care, you can help these animals overcome their fears and develop the necessary skills and confidence to thrive in their new environments.

- **Time commitment:** There are several ways you can foster with us from short term support, long term support, emergency support or critical care.
- Fosters provide an HBSPCA foster pet with love, food, water, shelter, safety, ongoing training and proper socialization, and medical care as prescribed. The HBSPCA foster program provides all food, crate, leash/harness and items required for your foster pet. Foster parents = are responsible for attending all appointments medical and otherwise at the HSBPCA. Foster parents are responsible for transporting pets to and from the shelter to your home. Volunteers are required to attend the HBSPCA with their animal on a regular, typically biweekly basis, for appointments.
