



Foster Job Description

Adventure Tails Foster

Position Description:

Adventure Tails Fosters work directly with the foster team to help enrich the lives of our shelter dogs. Fosters will take a shelter dog for a day out to provide a break from shelter life and to document observations on how they interact in new environments.

Pet Resource Center provides each Adventure Tail foster volunteer with an Adventure Tails goody bag that includes poop bags, a water bowl, a toy, a bag of treats and an "Adopt Me" bandanna. Adventure Tails can be scheduled 7 days a week, excluding holidays. Pickup appointments are scheduled in the morning 9:30am-10am, later pick up appointments available on a case-by-case basis. Return appointments are scheduled between 2pm-5:30pm.

Meeting the PRC Mission:

Fosters in this role help provide some of the best care possible for our shelter dogs. Engaging notes and photos about Adventure Tails dogs will help adopters make an informed decision and the shelter dogs will have an enriching day out.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Contact the Foster Team a day ahead of your outing with the ID and name of the dog you will be taking out, or request that the Foster Team select a dog for you.
- Take at least 4 photos of your Adventure Tails dog while out on your day trip.
- Fill out the Adventure Tails Report Card after your trip to provide information about the dog you took out. Additional notes can be emailed to the Foster Team.
- Adhere to the Adventure Tails Guidelines which you will receive.
- Operate a personal vehicle to safely transport dogs off-site.

Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years of age or older.
- Must possess a valid driver's license with fewer than 7 points against it.
- Ability to understand, remember, and follow exact instructions and procedures.
- Ability to work independently as required by the foster assignment.

Expected Hours of Service:

This position is flexible for fosters. Ideally fosters in the position will complete 1 Adventure Tails per month, or 1 every other month if volunteering in other areas of PRC. Dogs must be returned to PRC no later than 5:30pm.
